## **CCTG AstraZeneca Clinical Trials Fellowship**

The Canadian Cancer Trials Group is accepting applications for the AstraZeneca Clinical Trials Fellowship. This one-year position is open to motivated individuals from the disciplines of Hematology, Surgical, Medical and Radiation Oncology.

This Fellowship offers exposure to all aspects of clinical trial conduct including protocol development, execution and analysis in the setting of an internationally recognized research organization based in Kingston, Ontario. The experience will be tailored to the interests of the successful candidate and will establish the fundamentals of a future career as a clinical trialist in an academic setting.

International candidates must verify eligibility for an educational visa in Canada (<http://www.cic.gc.ca/english/information/applications/student.asp>) prior to application submission. Salary will be determined by the Canadian Cancer Society Research Institute scales. All applicants are encouraged to apply for external sources of funding for salary support and this will be considered in the review and final selection process.

Formal review of applications will occur in October and March.
