HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN A

CANCER CLINICAL TRIAL

Are you considering taking part in a cancer clinical trial? Many of the cancer treatments available today are because of individuals like you volunteering to take part.



UNDERSTAND

Talk with your health care team to understand the nature of your diagnosis. Ask them what clinical trials are right for you.





Search for trial information on the canadiancancertrials.ca website. It is a bilingual, database of cancer trials conducted in Canada.



Look at the **AVAILABLE TRIALS** for your type of cancer. Is the trial accepting patients? Is the trial available at your cancer center?



Talk to your **HEALTH CARE TEAM** about the trials you are interested in. They may also know about other trials that are open.



When you find the right trial you will be asked to sign a form confirming your **INFORMED CONSENT**.
Read this carefully before signing.



Then you will be asked to undergo some **TESTS** to ensure that you are eligible to participate and the trial is right for you!
