

## CCTG AstraZeneca Breast Cancer Fellowship

The Canadian Cancer Trials Group is accepting applications for the AstraZeneca Breast Cancer Fellowship.

This one-year position is open to motivated individuals from the disciplines of Surgical, Medical and Radiation Oncology.

Using the extensive databases compiled from breast cancer studies conducted within our organization, the motivated candidate will complete a research project in an area of interest such as basic tumour biology, molecular genetics, proteomics, outcome assessments, toxicity, quality of life issues and supportive care in all stages of disease. This fellowship position also allows exposure to other aspects of clinical trial conduct inherent in the day-to-day running of our organization.

International candidates must verify eligibility for an educational visa in Canada (<http://www.cic.gc.ca/english/information/applications/student.asp>) prior to application submission.

Salary will be determined by the Canadian Cancer Society Research Institute scales. All applicants are encouraged to apply for external sources of funding for salary support and this will be considered in the review and final selection process.
